Born in 1978, Tokyo. Graduated Keio University and studied under Makoto Sato at the Film School of Tokyo. Joined SIGLO, film production and distribution company. Worked for Japan's Peace Constitution (Directed by John Junkerman), All Around Us (Directed by Ryosuke Hashiguchi), Wandering Home (Directed by Yoichi Higashi) as a staff. Her first documentary film *Barefoot Gen's Hiroshima* (2011) which documented the eye-witness account of manga artist Keiji Nakazawa's atomic bomb experience, won the 17th Peace & Cooperative Journalist Fund of Japan Award's Encouragement Award. Published a nonfiction book *Meeting Hiroshima's trees* (2015). Now, she is making a documentary film on the trees survived the atomic bomb.
