Building (Kumamoto University Kurokami North Campus)

Eligibility: Those who satisfy all the following conditions.

- (1) Morning Class : <u>Have not learned Japanese before</u> and have basic English proficiency
- (2) Afternoon Class: <u>Have taken the first half of the course</u> in 2018 or 2019, or have equivalent proficiency (There will be a test of selection)
- University Student/Faculty/Researchers or their spouses who reside in Kumamoto Prefecture (Age 18 or older)
- (4) Can attend <u>all 12 classes</u>.

Number of recruited students: up to 10 people (per course)

*Morning class: There will be a lottery if the number of application exceeds the capacity. **Afternoon class: There will be a selection based on the test result.
