• **Beginner level later half 1: Starts from Feb.15 (Online)**

Application Duration: From Jan.17 to Feb. 10

• **Beginner level later half 2: Starts from Mar.2 (Online)**

Application Duration: From Jan.17 to Feb. 25

Eligibility: Those who satisfy all of the following conditions.

- (1) For later half 1 (learning N5 level Japanese), those who understood or has taken First half level (Kurokami) course.
For later half 2 (learning N4 level Japanese), those who understood or has taken later half 1 level course.
- (2) Are Kumamoto University Students/Faculty/Researchers or their spouses.
- (3) Can attend all classes in the course and manage the schedule. *See the schedule.

Number of recruited students: up to proximate of 8 people for each course.

* There will be a lottery if the number of applications exceeds the capacity.

Fee: Free

These courses will have many worksheet practices and exercises. No textbooks are required for these courses.

Level: Beginner (Entry level later half 1 or 2)
